Qualities of artistic research in the Global South: Confrontations and Proximities

This panel discussion takes as a starting point the Knowledge Production and Research in Art/s Practice online conference hosted by the Shiva Nadar University, New Delhi, in September 2021. Reflecting on the conference and ongoing practices of the four panelists, the presentation considers how artistic research in the global South takes on distinctive qualities, more particularly those that engage notions of confrontation and proximity. Furthermore, the panelists consider how artistic research conversations might be encouraged across global South practices.

Professor Premjish Achari

Premjish Achari is a curator and art critic based in Delhi. Achari has initiated an in-depth curatorial platform, called Future Collaborations, aimed at theoretically and politically informed curation. He is the co-curator of the Bhubaneswar Art Trail 2018. Achari currently heads the programme and the editorial for the exhibition 'Lokame Tharavadu' organised by the Kochi Biennale Foundation and teaches art history and theory at Shiv Nadar University. He is the winner of the Art Writers' Award 2021 issued by Swiss Arts Council Pro Helvetia, along with TAKE on Art.

Professor Anchia Anzi

Professor Achia Anzi is an artist and researcher based in New Delhi. Anzi is an Associate Professor of visual arts at Jindal School of Liberal Arts and Humanities, OP Jindal Global University, Sonipat (India), and a PhD candidate at Amsterdam School for Cultural Analysis.
